



Data Escrow

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We are compliant with Specification 2 of the ICANN Registry Agreement (v 2024) concerning the escrow process.

Part A Section 4	Processing of deposit files	• We tar up the deposit file tarball is compressed via Apache's compress library • tar is encrypted via openPGP with both escrow agent and RSP public key • tar is then signed with RSP private key, and digital signature file is generated. • signed tar and signature file is then transferred to the escrow agent (NCC Group) via sftp • NCC group then validates escrow file
Part A Section 5	File naming conventions	this is our naming convection <code>{gTLD}{YYYY-MM-DD}{type}_S{#}_R{rev}.{ext}</code> where: • {gTLD} is replaced with the gTLD name; in case of an IDN-TLD, the ASCII-compatible form (A-Label) must be used; • {YYYY-MM-DD} is replaced by the date corresponding to the time used as a timeline watermark for the transactions; i.e. for the Full



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		Deposit corresponding to 2009-08-02T00:00Z, the string to be used would be “2009-08-02”; • {type} is replaced by: ○ “full”, if the data represents a Full Deposit; ○ “diff”, if the data represents a Differential Deposit; • {#} is replaced by the position of the file in a series of files, beginning with “1”; in case of a lone file, this must be replaced by “1”. • {rev} is replaced by the number of revision (or resend) of the file beginning with “0”: • {ext} is replaced by “sig” if it is a digital signature file of the quasi-homonymous file. Otherwise it is replaced by “ryde”.
